PROPERTY MANAGER NEWS

Yearly Inspections are scheduled for the week of April 22nd. Thank you in advance for your cooperation as the staff will quickly enter your apartment to complete their inspection.



Please allow the maintenance staff to focus on their tasks!

Questions regarding meetings, events, pest control protocols, move in/out concerns, cable, etc. are to be directed to your property manager.

Leave these clips on your door frame. They will be used to deliver flyers. As with all PHHC property, do not damage or remove items from their



intended use.

Time for a refresher:

- Pets are to be on a leash when outside your apartment. Do NOT leave dogs on a lead outside! ALWAYS pick up after your pet.
- Review the NO SMOKING policy.
- Please update your Property Manager of any changes to your phone number
- NEVER EVER flush wipes or hygiene products!

When you signed your lease with PHHC you agreed to requirements to obtain and keep your subsidized housing. A portion of your rent is paid for by the federal government. HUD has set an "acceptable" status for housekeeping. When PHHC staff enters your home, part of their job is to report on the condition. If it is sub-standard Per **HUD** requirements that is a lease violation. Three lease violations in a year can result in the loss of your lease.
