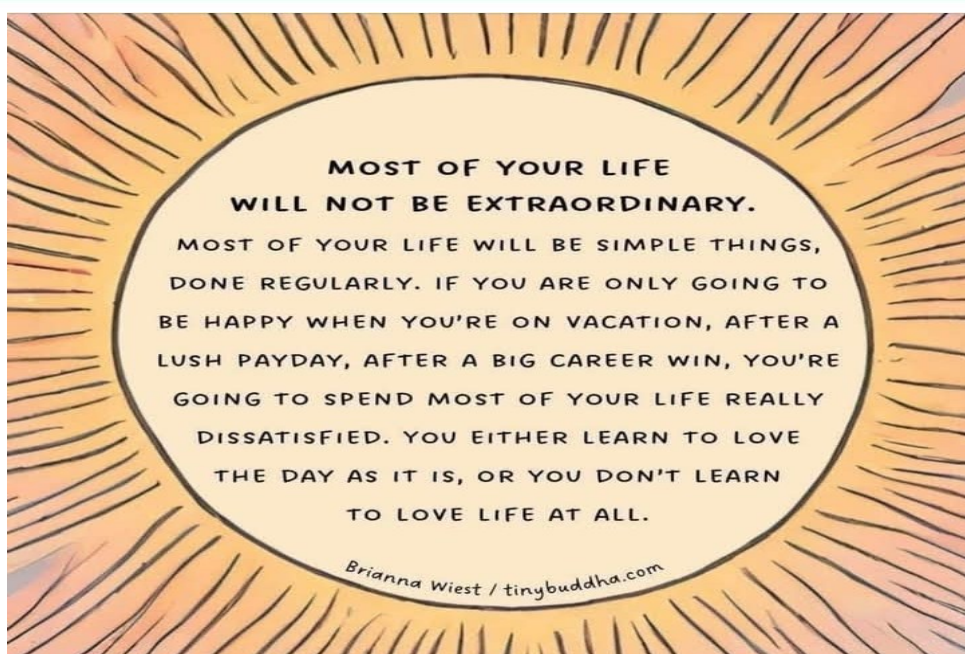

Please continue to report any pests to the housing commission.

- ⇒ Absolutely NO wipes or sanitary items down the toilets.
- ⇒ All tenants are required to keep their space (especially the bathrooms) clean and hygienic.
- ⇒ All pets must be registered and up to date on their paperwork. See the pet policy.
- ⇒ Vehicles must be operational if parked on PHHC property.
- ⇒ After hour lock out fee is \$100. After 3 lock outs during business hours in a 6 month period, they will be charged at \$30 each.

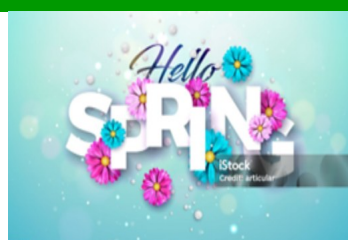
