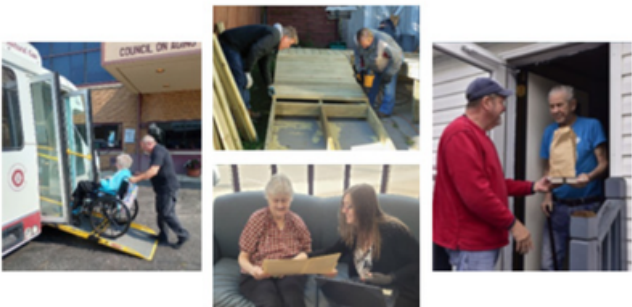

Please be aware that when reminders are put in the newsletter it is an attempt to educate new tenants and remind seasoned ones to help them be aware and avoid violations or evictions. Choosing to smoke in your apartment, having roomer and boarders beyond the allowable time, not following the pet policy, storing bikes in your apartment, not wearing shoes when outside of your apartment, poor housekeeping status, and behaviors (drinking in public areas or intoxication and destruction to property) are all avoidable violations. . You choose to not follow policies and therefore there are consequences. If I can help people with a reminder of what leads to violations then maybe a person will make different choices. Think about it this way, your housing is important! Please ask questions if you don't understand a policy, ask for help if needed, and please choose to make your housing

stability a priority
